What does a coach need to do in order for students to participate?

This is not like a local tournaement where one can just 'sign up" and pay entry fees. A school's NSDA roster determines the amount of entries that school can enter for the district tournament. The more students on your roster, the more entries your school is eligible to enter at Districts! (i.e., GET THOSE POINTS IN!!)

Read through the invitation information (this document) and note the specific deadlines and requirements.
Join or renew the National Speech & Debate Association (this is a separate registration from the New Jersey Speech & Debate League). Enter your students names, emails and passwords and have them confirm.
Link your students to Tabroom and Speechwire which will allow autoposting. Make sure their names and emails are identical between NSDA and Tabroom.com. You can use the syncing functions to assist with this.
Enter your students' points or use the autoposting feature if it has been previously enabled. Points can be earned at any local, regional or national tournament; however they must be recorded ahead of districts. Remember, students can also earn points for specific 'service' categories!
Once a student earns 25 NSDA points, their lifetime dues must be purchased before registering for the district series. This is membership fee is separate from and does not include the student's entry fee(s) at the district tournament.
Once a student becomes a member of the NSDA with 25 points, they are eligible to compete in the District Series!!! Congratulations! Now you have to enter them.

We're registered.... now what?

This is the perfect time to ensure that your students' materials and performances adhere to NSDA regulations and procedures.

Review the most recent NSDA Unified Manual with your team. Have them read through the specific regulations associated with their event(s) to avoid risking disqualification.
Have your interpretation students <u>review the rules</u> and complete the documentation process now, rather than right before the event. Share this template with your students so you can review their material with them. <u>njsdl.live/interp</u>
Have your oratory and informative students <u>review the rules</u> and update their scripts and references to ensure they're current and any sources are accessible. Share this template with your students so you can review their material with them. <u>njsdl.live/speech</u>
<u>A</u> ll original scripts and updated manuscripts (for all speech events except USX and IX) must be available at all district tournament contests in the event of a protest. You can see what constitutes an original script/manuscript in the event rules linked above.
Review the rules for internet and evidence use with your students in the following events so you can be sure they understand their importance and follow proper procedures.

- Extemporaneous Speaking
- <u>Congressional Debate</u>
- Public Forum, Lincoln Douglas and Policy Debate

Generative Artificial Intelligence: At the 2024 National Tournament, in events in which speeches must be the original created work of a competitor (OO, INF, IX, USX, SW, EXC, IMP), students are prohibited from quoting or paraphrasing text directly from generative AI sources. Generative AI should not be cited as a source. The exception is that a student delivering a speech about the topic of AI may quote AI to illustrate their points about AI, in accordance with existing quoted word limits. While generative AI may be used to guide students to articles, ideas, and sources, the original source of any quoted or paraphrased evidence must be available if requested. In debate events, generative AI should not be cited as a source; while generative AI may be used to guide students to articles, ideas, and sources, the original source of any quoted or paraphrased evidence must be available if requested. In Interpretation events, students are prohibited from performing material created by generative AI sources. Generative AI should not be used as a source of material; while generative AI may be used to guide students to articles, ideas, and material, the original source of any material that is performed must be available if requested.

All schools, new and returning, should complete the following information and remit annual dues payment each year [note that many schools pre-pay their annual dues in conjunction with the previous year's state championship tournament registration fees].
